

This Week in Third Grade...



Math: This week in 3A, we will be ending Module 1 which focused on the conceptual understanding and properties of both multiplication and division. On Tuesday and Wednesday students will review number bonds, the commutative property and the relationship between multiplication and division. We will play an assortment of games, independent and partner activities to review all concepts learned throughout the unit. On Thursday, students will complete their study guide and Friday will be the End of Module 1 Test.

Reading: This week, students will be engaging in a variety of literature as we review the importance of theme, plot, characterization, conflict/resolution and other important elements of literature. In addition, we will be introducing cause and effect and as an important skill within literature. Our Main Selection will be Roberto Clemente. In addition, we will be celebrating other baseball stars as well as Pele (Hispanic soccer player) as we continue on with Hispanic Heritage Month.

Grammar: This week, we will be continuing on with types of nouns as we continue to review utilizing noun charts as well as introducing singular possessive and plural possessive nouns. We will be completing a variety of application activities that practice singular and plural possessives as well as other types of nouns. On Friday, students will be engaging with a "Spooky Menu Project." Students will pretend they are a restaurant owner and design and spooky meal that others may want to try. This will be a review of possessives, singular, plural, common and proper nouns in context.

Writing/ Handwriting: Students will be engaging in a few handwriting samples, and we will also begin our handwriting unit this week focusing on the cursive letters. We will review letters t, i, s, u, e, l, f and learn a few more letters as well. In writing this week, we will be beginning to formulate our first recount narrative. The goal is really focused, clear, concise writing with complete sentences. We will conclude the first draft of our personal narrative at the end of this week.

STEAM: We will be taking our second science TEST on Thursday of this week (Chapter Two) after engaging in the final few chapters of our Science Book, discussing various groups of animals and their features as well as designing our Science Vocabulary Cube as an ending project. We will also be diving into Social Studies where we will be learning about where we live in relationship to the world. Students will begin to learn their continents and oceans as well as Pennsylvania history in a creative way!

Spelling: Spelling words for this week can be found on Google Classroom via spelling city. Test will be Friday in the morning! Vocabulary words can also be found on Google Classroom as well via quizlet to practice!
