

Math: This week in math we will continue understanding the concept behind multiplication using arrays and determining equal size and equal group. In addition, we will spend much of the week understanding the concept behind division and how it relates to multiplication. Towards the end of the week we will be learning about the commutative property of multiplication and distributive property! Word problems, independent work and partner work will be completed throughout the week! Students began learning their multiplication facts last week! Practice sheets will be distributed next week to take home if the student so desires.

Reading: This week, we will be beginning our second reading Unit focusing on The

Trial of Cardigan Jones. In addition, we will be learning about what a course case looks like as well as laws that have been changed by our world's greatest heroes! Students will be focusing on the skill of drawing conclusions, making inferences as well as learning robust character traits, setting and the central message of the story. A new trade book from the library will be sent home on Wednesday and Thursday to read that goes along with our theme of "laws!"

Read Aloud: This week we will begin our novel entitled "The Wish Tree." We will be reading this read-aloud side by side together and focusing on different points of view!

Writing/ Handwriting: We will be completing our compare and contrast piece this week by carrying out the revision and editing process. Students will also be starting the first mini-narrative/memoir following the prompt of "My proudest moment." We will review the parts of a narrative and the prewriting process. Students will also begin re-

Grammar: This week, focus will be on learning simple subjects and predicates as well as complete subjects and predicates. We will also focus on recognizing and fixing fragments and run-on sentences as well as writing the four

Science: We will continue our Plant Life Science Unit through the investigation of various groups of plants, plant reactions, etc. Students will participate in hands-on centers and rotations to learn these concepts!
