

This Week in Third Grade...

Math: Students need to continue practicing their multiplication facts! Students will be tested on counting money up to \$10.00 on Wednesday, November 4, 2015. In addition, students will be tested on making change appropriately and adding coins together. Towards the end of this week, we will be beginning a new unit on measuring weight and liquid volume in metric units.

Reading: Students will continue to analyze character and practice finding main idea and details through the close-reading of tall-tales. We will be beginning our reader's theatre practice this week.

Writing: Students will end the narrative writing unit this week by writing one final narrative about a moment where they accomplished something great. On Friday, students will be given a narrative prompt and will have one hour to respond to this prompt using all of the techniques we have practiced thus far!

Social Studies: This week, we will continue to talk about the the natural resources, climate and geographical location of various states around The United States. Students will complete their written reports about their assigned state and important historical destination. After compiling and organizing their information, students will learn how to write an information report. Formal voice, organization and revision are three elements that will be discussed throughout this process.
