This Week in Third Grade...

Math: Continue to have students work on their addition and subtraction facts at home as well as their multiplication flashcards! This week in math, students are using arrays, tape diagrams and number bonds to explore the relationships between multiplication and division.

Reading: Students have now switched into their reading groups. The skill for this unit is using close-reading to find the main idea and supporting details.

Writing: Students will continue to write their personal narrative memoir of their most recent memory! We will continue through the prewriting stages of completing our graphic organizers and then move into the formal writing stages.

Science: This week will be the last week devoted to ecosystems, food chains, photosynthesis and predator/prey relationships.
