This Week in Third Grade...

Math: Students need to continue practicing their two's and three's. Students should be able to solve 48 problems in two minutes! This week in math students will take their end of Unit 1 test on Wednesday. In addition, we will be beginning our time and measurement unit starting on Thursday.

Reading: Students will be working in their small reading group to identify main idea, close read, and ask questions. This week, we will be diving into "biographies" as well as reader's theatre.

Writing: Students will complete their first "narrative." On Monday, we will learn how to edit our work like true authors. Students will take an informal writing assessment on Wednesday. They will be asked to respond to a cold prompt. Towards the end of the week, we will begin our second "memoir" about their memory that occurred years ago.

Social Studies: We will begin our new social studies unit this week! Students will be learning about the differences between continents, countries and cities. Hemispheres will be discussed.
