

This Week in Third Grade...

Math: Students need to continue practicing their multiplication facts! Students will continue working through the measurement unit while learning about kilograms and grams as well as liters and milliliters. In addition, students will solve multi-step complex word problems related to measurement and will begin rounding to the nearest tens and hundreds place. A tentative Math test will take place on Friday, November 13th on measurement! Students will receive a study guide before this test takes place!

Reading: Students will continue to analyze character and practice finding main idea and details through a variety of genres. This week, we will begin a new reading unit! The students will be practicing sequencing as well as determining text importance.

Writing: Students will write one final narrative this week for me over a two-day period. Later this week, we will begin our realistic fiction writing unit. We will complete our Grammar Unit on Nouns on Tuesday! Students will take their grammar test on Thursday! I will send home a study guide in addition to our reviews in class.

Social Studies: Students completed their first formal Social Studies report based on a specific state and destination that they researched! These projects are just fabulous! We will be sharing these projects this coming week. In addition, students will be discussing the physical geography of our community.
