This Week in Third Grade...

Math: We will begin this week with a few review concepts including telling time, multi-step word problems, thinking critically and accurately, counting money, place value, addition and subtraction. Next week, we will be jumping right into the third grade Math Curriculum with a starting focus on multiplication!

Reading: This week, we will be introducing the importance of the Socratic Seminar method in our classroom, asking critical

elements and reviewing the important characteristics of a third grade reader! Our literature selection for this week is entitled <u>A New School Year (Stories in Six Voices.)</u> This is a beautiful selection of stories and their different perspectives of their first day of school, their family lives, their worries and their triumphs. It is an excellent way to discuss character traits as well as changing points of view, empathy and kindness.

Read Aloud: This week we will begin with a few smaller read-aloud selections to prepare us for our beginning of the year novel entitled Wishtree. We are focusing specifically on the beauty of diversity as well as important literary themes that we can take with us throughout life!

Writing/ Handwriting: We will squeeze in a quick handwriting sample this week before starting our journey through the cursive letters (next week!) In addition, we are going to begin a global comparison between our school day lives and the lives of students living in Kenya. We will discuss important similarities and differences this week through small clips, magazine articles, etc. Eventually, this will become our first writing assignment as we begin to make comparisons across cultures as well as learning how to write a compare an

Science: Science this week will consist of a few STEM activities that promote critical thinking, collaboration, question-asking, determination and cooperation! We will begin our Life Science Unit next week!


